Professional Mentorship Program



The following long answer questions are on the online application. It is advantageous to prepare your answers in advance and save for future reference

1. Mentee Background

Briefly summarize your previous experience in the chosen artistic discipline. How long have you been involved? This can include formal, informal training, other experience. (Max 150 words)

2. Mentorship Program Proposal

Propose how you plan to use this mentorship - summarizing your creative work, and areas you would like to focus on with your mentor over the 7 month program. What do you plan to achieve? Is there a specific project you would like to work on with your mentor? Or skills / connections you'd like to make? Be as specific as you can with your plan.

***Keep in mind due to COVID-19 health restrictions this program will likely take place digitally, or allowing for only small, distanced in person meeting. If you're applying in the live arts, is there a focus that can run independent of whether they are opened back up this program year? (Max 250 words)*

3. Career Perspective

Explain why you feel this is an optimum time in your career trajectory to participate in this mentorship program, and how it may help you in your artistic career right now.
